- Provide meals for weekly cohort gatherings
- Provide or help pack study snack bags for participants' mid-term and finals season
- Provide or help pack holiday gift bags
- Provide or help pack graduation gift bags
- Provide or help pack heading to 4-year college gift bags for our transfer students

8. MENTORSHIP (start date tbd)

- Commit to 1-3 months - 1 year of mentoring a participant. We're especially looking for someone who's working or has worked in the field the participant is pursuing
